Poster presentations reporting empirical research 30”x 40” in size. The poster is similar to a compressed version of a research paper written in APA style. Handouts are not required, but they are recommended. Posters are encouraged to cover a range of areas related to ABA including autism, OBM, staff/parent training, concept formation, etc.

- 3. Abstract** (150 – 200 words, double spaced following APA guidelines)
- 4. Contact Person** (Please list one person responsible for correspondence with NJABA regarding submission. Please provide name, affiliation, preferred e-mail **and** mailing address, phone, and fax)
- 5. Author(s)** (Please provide name(s) and affiliation(s))
